

Rugby Link Update #3 March 2017

Rugby Link Version registrations are well underway, with Competitions beginning to kick-off

➤ 2017 Season setup

- In 2017, Clubs and Associations **Online Self-Registration is mandatory**. In exceptional circumstances where players cannot register online, Clubs are required to input player data into Rugby Link.
- Non-playing members are also required to register – this is anybody with an official role at your Club or Association.

➤ NEW Online Registration Forms

- ALL Clubs **will need to create NEW** online registration forms for season 2017. This is to ensure the member sign-up form enhancements are effective including parent/ guardian workflow, ethnicity questions, school dropdown list plus reducing the transaction fee from 2.9% to 1.88%.
- **NOTE:** no 2016 form templates should be used. You can continue to edit/ update existing registration products.

➤ New Rugby Link Version 3 Releases now Available!

- Part-payments and more flexible payment options for registrations have just been released into Rugby Link (Thursday 9 March).

- 'Bulk Import' function has been removed from Rugby Link.
 - The Bulk Import function had not been developed to capture all new member signup fields (parent/ guardian workflow, ethnicity questions, etc.) As all players need to self-register from 2017 onwards, the need for Bulk Import is no longer required.
- Rugby Link Accreditations:
 - As part of the wider Canopi - ARU Learning Centre accreditation project, whereby the accreditation structure is being updated to reflect the ARU accreditation workflow, all accreditation information will be deleted from Rugby Link today.
 - Individual participants and ARU Learning Centre administrators will be able to continue to check accreditations via the Learning Centre portal.
- Penalty Tries are now worth 7 points in accordance with World Rugby law updates.
- Family Relationship Report:
 - Clubs can now report on Parent/ Guardian details entered during online registration process plus any additional Parent/ Guardian and sibling relationships.
