

Rugby Link Update #6 June 2017

Rugby Link Version 4 development requirement gathering begins

➤ Case Management – Phase 2 Releases

- Case Management tabs are now available at State, Region and National level which is important for State and National Championships.
- Match Manager actions now include buttons which are linked to Case Management pages, allowing easy checking of entered injuries or incidents at Competition level.
- Incident Detail Report, Incident Discrepancy Report and Injury Detail Report can now only be accessed via *Competition Management > People > Case Management > Reports*.
- Number of yellow cards attributed to a player ID will calculate across a single season. While season total has been replaced by 'No. of Guilty Suspensions' and 'No. of Confirmed Concussions' which will also calculate across a single season.
- Existing 'Suspensions/ Exclusions' page has been removed, plus Injury/ Incident tabs have been removed from the Player Statistics page.

➤ New Rugby Link Version 3 Releases now Available!

- Clubs 'disputing' a match result will now be required to enter a mandatory explanation as to why they are disputing the match.
- Media Extract enhancement includes adding the initial of the player in the download.
- Registration Enterprise Report (available for download at State level only) enhancements including adding ethnicity, school and next of kin.

➤ New Rugby Link Version 3 Releases Coming Soon!

- Case Management – Phase 3:
 - Injury/ Incident Notifications sent to Club admin and Competition Manager when:
 - A case is created for a Player- red card, concussion, citing and breach code of conduct
 - A case is created for a Team Official- breach code of conduct
 - A serious injury is reported by a Club.
 - The ability for Competition Managers to store and share case management files through Rugby Link.
