

Rugby Link Update #7 July 2017

Rugby Link Version 4 development requirement has been scoped and scheduled for Rugby Season 2018

➤ Case Management – Phase 2 Releases

- Injury/ Incident Notifications sent to Club admin and Competition Manager when:
 - A case is created for a Player- red card, concussion, citing and breach code of conduct
 - A case is created for a Team Official- breach code of conduct
 - A serious injury is reported by a Club
- Case Management new filtering options added – ‘All Status’ and/ or ‘All Scenes’
- Incident and Injury Enterprise Reports are now available at State level

➤ Case Management – Phase 3 Releases

- Ability for Competition Managers to store and share case management evidence for incidents and injuries, including:
 - Upload any evidence files for the injury/incident case - includes documents - word, pdf, excel, images, photos and video etc
 - Generate, copy and then share the public file links for each file item you want to share with individuals via email for the case
 - Individuals can view, download and update documents if required. Note, these individuals do not require access into Rugby Link
 - Upload any completed documents for the case before closing it, which triggers the share links to become private (unable to be accessed by the public/individuals that were provided share links)

➤ New Rugby Link Version 3 Releases now Available!

- State admin users can download an Accreditation Enterprise Report to show all accreditations against an individual’s record in Rugby Link

➤ New Rugby Link Version 3 Releases Coming Soon!

- Case Management – ability for ARU and State admin users to delete erroneous case management entries
- Matches Played Report Enhancement to include team name in the report at both Club and Association level
- Bulk Fixture Report Download in Match Manager will include Home Team ID, Away Team ID and Venue ID
- Accreditation Enhancements on the individual’s record, the on-screen report and a new download available at Club and Association level
