

Rugby Link Update January 2018

Another Rugby Season is upon us!

➤ 2018 Rugby Season for Participants

- In 2018, Clubs and Associations must adhere to the following registration regulatory requirements:
 - Online self-registration for ALL players, non-playing members (committee members and team officials - coaches, managers, first aid/medical staff etc.) and match officials; and
 - Online payment for ALL Players (full or part payment).
- All **participants** will be required to login via the **NEW** look Rugby Portal - <https://rugby.force.com/rugbyportal>.
 - NOTE: Admin login remains the same via Rugby Link admin portal.
- Registrations open from Thursday 4 January 2018

➤ New Rugby Link Version 4 Releases Now Available!

- Automatic part payments available whereby if Clubs offer part payments, participants can decide to pay their registration in fees in 1, 2, 3 or 4 payments. Participants credit/ debit card will automatically be deducted on the 16th of the subsequent month(s).
- Participant Portal upgrade (login through Rugby AU portal) to allow participants to update payment, credit card details for part payments.
- Additional Accreditations (Team Managers, Competition Managers, Medical and Member Protection) added into Rugby Link so Club admins can report on these.
- Grade settings enhancements – Competition Managers can now enforce Team Manager and Assistant Referee selection on team sheets, in conjunction with enforcing Coach selection.
- Participant Logins screen has been reinstated, Clubs can now send MyRugby IDs to their players to assist with the login process.

➤ NSW Active Kids Rebate

- *What is Active Kids Rebate?*
 - NSW Government will provide a \$100 voucher to parents/guardians of school enrolled children. The \$100 voucher can be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities.
- *Where do I find out the details?*
 - Participants can check their eligibility and begin to apply for their voucher on the NSW Services [website](#) from 31 Jan.
- *Can this be used for Rugby?*
 - Yes, from late Friday 2 February, you can use your NSW Active Kids vouchers when paying your registration fees in Rugby Link.
